## Sledge Hockey

Our season starts <u>Sunday</u>, <u>October 26<sup>th</sup></u> and goes through to Sunday, March 15th from 2 PM to 3PM, at the Waterford Arena. Please arrive at the arena in time to be on the ice by 2 PM.

Please print of the attached registration form for sledge hockey, as well as a Game Schedule if you wish to play hockey this year. Complete the registration form and return it to me at 46 Berkley Crescent, Simcoe, N3Y 2K5 with your cheque for \$60 made payable to South Coast Special Needs Kids, prior to October 15th. For insurance purposes a registration form must be completed and received by me prior to October 15th in order for players to go on the ice.

If you have a sledge bring it with you, otherwise a sledge will be assigned to you on October 26<sup>th</sup>. Also, please bring your hockey jersey. If you are a new player, we will give you a jersey at the arena. All players must wear a helmet and upper and lower body protection while on the ice. It is **MANDATORY** that all players wear a neck protector - check your local Canadian Tire or Wal-Mart to purchase one - players will not be allowed on the ice without a neck protector.

#### PLEASE NOTE:

Players who are unable to propel themselves will need to bring their own
"buddy-pusher".
Helpers on the ice MUST wear a helmet for liability reasons.
All players must be in a sledge, and only buddy-pushers and coaches can
be on the ice with the players.

Please ensure that your sledge hockey player is accompanied by someone who is physically capable to transfer the player from a wheelchair to their sledge either manually or by using the lift.

### <u>Basketball</u>

We will begin basketball on <u>Wednesday</u>, <u>October 15<sup>th</sup> at 6:15 PM</u>. This is a no charge, drop-in activity held at First Baptist Church in Simcoe. The gymnasium is accessible by elevator, so please come out and join us!!
